IMMEDIATE DENTURES

- **Do not** remove the denture for 24 hours after the extractions have been done. The denture acts as a bandage at this time.
- After 24 hours, remove the denture, rinse and reinsert. (or wait until your check up visit in our office.)
- Refrain from smoking or using straws for **as least 24 hours** after the extractions have been done.
- Brush denture teeth with denture paste or with mild detergent and water. Do not brush denture with toothpaste.
- To soak, place the denture in a cup with a denture tablet or powder and water. After 15 to 20 minutes, rinse the denture well.
- Dentures can be stored in a cup or retainer case and a small amount of mouth wash, if desired. **(DO NOT store dentures in retainer case submersed in water.)**
- Note: commercial instructions enclosed in the denture kit are for use after the first month. Do not use denture adhesive products (ie Polygrip) until instructed by Dr. Kaylakie or oral surgeon.
